### The School Gates

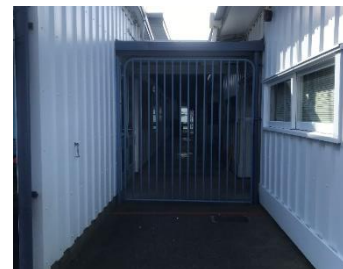
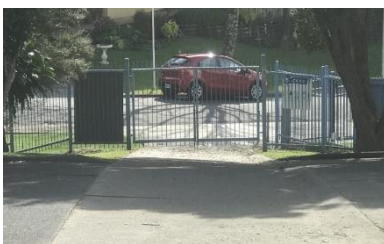


We take the safety of the children at Tirimoana School very seriously.

**Please be aware that the school gates at the Metric Place entrance and Tirimoana Road entrance are closed throughout the school day. Staff close the gates at 8.50am when the bell has rung.**

If your child is running late to school, they should be dropped off at the main entrance on Kokiri Street and come through the office for a late pass.

**If you do come through the gates when they are closed, please ensure you close them after you.**
