This week's PB4L focus: Showing Respect

Showing respect during singing and whole school assembly.

Learning at Tirimoana – caring teachers and motivated children

This week I have been visiting several different classes, from Y0 to Y6, observing the learning happening in science and in Literacy. I am pleased to say I have observed great teaching and excited, motivated children. Parents should be impressed that our teachers go the extra mile – planning and delivering their lessons with flair and skill; and, that children respond so well to well—planned, stimulating teaching.

Learning, in all its forms, is the primary purpose of schools. We teach children to self-manage their feelings, to be kind and friendly to each other, to resolve their frustrations or problems positively, to show respect, and to apply effort to their academic learning. This is happening all over our school, and it happens because of the dedication and passion of all our teachers.

I have also been supporting children who struggle, and teachers who face challenges from time to time. I am consistently impressed with the concern, the dedication, and the resilience of our teachers when they confront complex issues with children. Parents often do not see all the effort and genuine care teachers apply. For children that struggle, we show we recognise when they really try, and we always show that tomorrow is a new day, and we still have faith in you to succeed.

For me, a good school is one where all our teachers acknowledge the skills of each other. We call this collective efficacy, believing in each other. I visited a Year 6 class today where that was the teacher's goal – teaching the children to believe in their own capacity to be able, successful learners. It was a wonderful, masterful lesson that I observed.

In Year 4 I heard children talking with excitement and pride about their new spelling programme – believing in their capacity to be successful! From another Year 4 class I had excited children demonstrating static electricity! In a Year 0 class I observed children learning about the solar system with fascination and interest.

I plan to observe in more classes next week.



Children with peanut allergies

I remind all parents that sometimes we enrol children with severe allergic reactions to peanut. This is a stressful issue for parents to manage and they rely on school to support their child by keeping them safe. All parents can help by doing their best to not provide food with peanut in school lunches because you never know when another child in the room might be allergic and have a severe anaphylactic reaction. This issue has come up recently in Room 10. Parents of children with allergies trust us as teachers to keep their child safe. We are a community, so we can all help.

The School Gates

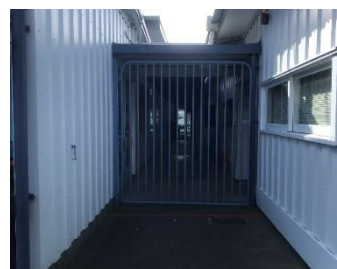
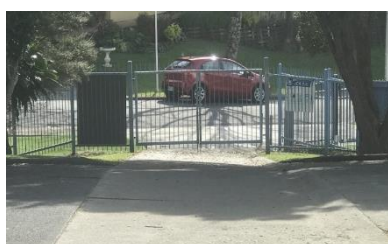


We take the safety of the children at Tirimoana School very seriously.

Please be aware that the school gates at the Metric Place entrance and Tirimoana Road entrance are closed throughout the school day. Staff close the gates at 8.50am when the bell has rung.

If your child is running late to school, they should be dropped off at the main entrance on Kokiri Street and come through the office for a late pass.

If you do come through the gates when they are closed, please ensure you close them after you.



The gate leading from the carpark to the library will also be closed.

Spare clothes – Wet weather



Please pack a spare set of clothes in your child's school bag.

During the winter terms, our field and grass areas around the school get wet and soggy and at times, children do slip over and get muddy. Our teachers do their best to encourage children to stick to the pathways and to keep off the field when it is very wet.

Please be mindful of where you are stopping your car or parking your car when dropping off or picking up your child.
