My big message this week is a big whakamihi / thank you to our parents. Parents have been overwhelmingly supportive and understanding of all the ways school tries to keep parents informed, children safe, and keep staff covering absences to enable children to continue to attend school.

We know that Omicron is widely circulating in the community and in schools. We also know that everyone is trying their best to keep safe, and to isolate themselves at home when they need to.

Thank you to parents for notifying school so reliably whenever you know that you have either a positive case at home or if a household member is a close contact of someone who is positive. This information is appreciated by school staff and helps us plan to keep others safe.

We also have staff at home isolating and some staff at home positive. Other staff are carrying the load at school. We check daily on our staff wellbeing, and we advise staff to stay home and isolate if they are unwell, show symptoms or are close contacts.

Each day and each week we get closer to the predicted peak surge of the virus. We know we are still likely to be 3-4 weeks away from this. In the meantime we continue to keep school open.


