Children coming back to school

As you will have seen, there is a reduction in the number of daily COVID cases. This is great news! At School, cases have reduced and over 84% of our students are now attending school everyday.

It is very important for all children's wellbeing and learning to be at school with their friends, teachers and other school staff.

Next term we want **all** children to be back at school and engaging in learning with their friends.

This means that if your child is not back at school to start Term 2, then we will contact you to ask why. Staying home if sick or if a close contact will be a justified absence. Staying home because you feel uncomfortable about a return to school will result in school contacting the Ministry of Education Attendance Service who will in turn contact you. We have received guidance from the Ministry of Education that all children should be back at school because the worst spread of the COVID Omicron virus has now passed.

If you have any concerns about sending your child to school, please get in touch – we are here to help.

Please remember that Tirimoana School has:

- Very good systems in place to keep everyone as safe as possible.
- Mask wearing for our students Year 4 and above and for adults remains in place in indoor spaces.
- Students are getting lots of fresh air during the day.
- We continue to focus on basic hygiene such as washing hands regularly, covering any coughs and sneezes, and cleaning surfaces regularly.
