#### **Celebrating Significant Religious and Cultural Events or Festivals**

New Zealand State schools are secular, meaning we do not promote or teach any religion. We know that we have families that recognise many different religions or faiths, and many who have no religious affiliation. We do however recognise that for some families these events or festivals are very important. It is also important that children learn to understand that people have different faiths and that they know about significant festivals.



Currently we are in the muslim festival of Ramadan. So, to all our muslim families we wish you a happy Ramadan. Ramadan is one of the most important festivals in the muslim faith, and all over the world it is recognised including here in New Zealand.

Next week is Easter, with Good Friday on 15 April. Easter is a very significant festival in the Christian calendar and is recognised as a Public Holiday in New Zealand. For children it is always synonymous with chocolate Easter Eggs!





During the school holidays, on 25 April, New Zealand and Australia recognise ANZAC Day. This is an important day for children to learn about New Zealanders who have served in the Armed Forces overseas, both in previous war zones and currently in areas of conflict around the world. School has an ANZAC display in the library and we are likely to recognise ANZAC Day at school early in Term 2.

Important festivals are now covered in the Aotearoa-New Zealand Histories in the school curriculum.
