This week's PB4L Focus: Goal Setting

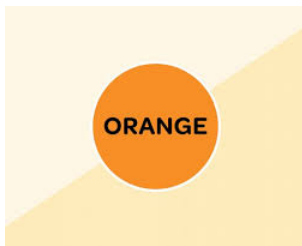

COVID Orange Protection Framework



The decision to move to Orange has been made on public health advice and reflects that we are moving past the peak of cases and our health system is able to cope. We are seeing that cases are declining due to high levels of vaccination and natural immunity after infection.

During the school holidays I will be working with the Senior Leadership team to update and confirm for the community and teachers what the move to Orange means in our school setting.

We will continue to keep all the other health measures in place at school that we know slow the spread of COVID-19. These include ensuring our indoor spaces are well-ventilated, maintaining good hand hygiene and cough and sneeze etiquette, appropriate physical distancing whenever we can and, most importantly, staying home if we are sick.

Face masks

Our understanding is that at Orange, face masks are no longer required at school. However public health advice is that masks continue to be strongly encouraged when indoors. Wearing a mask is a key health measure that slows the spread of COVID-19 in indoor settings.

School will communicate with you as to what recommendations we will put in place for term 2.

We are looking forward to a few less restrictions and returning to school life that is a bit closer to normal.

Have a Happy Easter and Safe holidays. We will see all children back at school ready for learning on Monday 2 May.
