We also spent time talking together about learning at school, gathering feedback and ideas from parents to help with our strategic planning.

Board Elections Q & A - Wednesday 29 June 7.00pm

This year school communities all over New Zealand will elect new boards to govern schools for the next 3 years. The national Board election date is 7 September.

This may seem far away but nominations for the election open on 15 July and close on 5 August.

Our school has appointed Jenny Atkins as Returning Officer for the election. She is busy updating postal and email addresses of parents and whanau, and will then prepare an Electoral Roll. Every parent of children at Tirimoana School is entitled to vote in the election. Voting papers will be sent out to parents registered on the electoral roll.

Next Wednesday evening we will hold a Question and Answer event for parents and whanau about the election process. We will also be encouraging parents to nominate for election to the new board, which will take office on 14 September. Please feel welcome to come along to the Q&A event to find out more about the election, and to consider nominating. Members of our current board will attend so that interested parents can talk with them about what being on the board entails.

We will be looking for at least 5 parents to nominate - you can nominate yourself, or you can nominate another person.

There will be no school on this day.

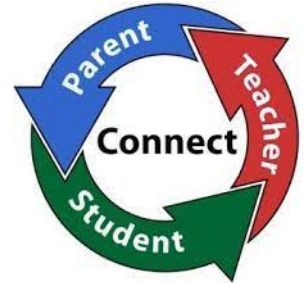
Your child will come back to school with you to attend their 3 Way Learning Conference.

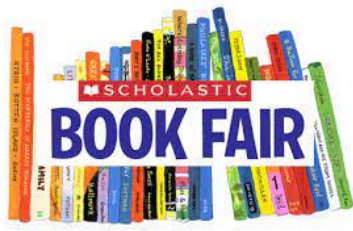
