Explore-Athon - the last few days to support this event!

Thank you to the many families that have supported our learning and fundraising Athon. Your support helps motivate children with their learning, and your sponsorship of your child's Athon will enable the school to build a new sunsail shade over our new sandpit. This is an \$11,000 project. All funds from the Athon will go towards this project.

So far we have raised around **\$6500** but we are hoping to reach **\$10,000**. 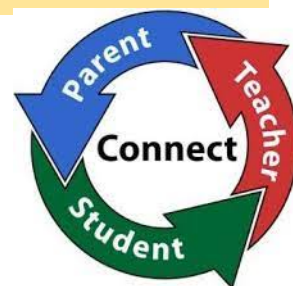
Three Way Conferences (Student/Parent/Teacher) : Wednesday 6 July

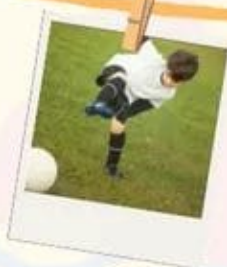
