## This week's PB4L Focus: Acting Responsibly towards Playground Problem Solving

### Wild, wet weather!

## Te Atatu Road Pedestrian Crossing

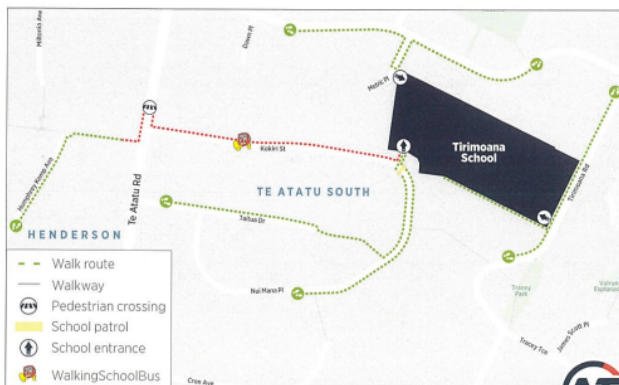
