Wearing our school uniform with pride

Teachers have noticed that some children are consistently not wearing all correct uniform requirements. It is a requirement that children wear the correct uniform, including footwear. This is outlined in the Tirimoana School Board Uniform Policy.

School always understands that on occasions a child may not have the full uniform - on a cold day needing to wear a different warm jacket, on days when the washing is still on the line because of wet weather, when awaiting a new uniform order, or when items are briefly lost. These occasions should be only for a brief time.

If the cost of uniform items is a problem for a family, then please talk with Jenny in the office, or with one of our deputy principals. We also regularly have second hand uniform sales where families can buy good quality items at low prices.

Most notable non uniform items include multi coloured leggings or stockings, brightly coloured shoes (eg red) and brightly coloured undershirts (eg thermals) worn under the uniform T-shirt.



We advise the following items can be worn with the uniform:

Undershirts or long sleeved T-shirts that are navy blue or black.

Black shoes or black sandals. Black or navy blue tights.



Please support your child by having the correct uniform for school. Thank you for your support.

This only applies to 5-Year-olds who have not pre enrolled.

Applicants are accepted in the following order:

Out of Zone Application Priorities	
Second priority	Siblings of current students.
Third priority	Siblings of former students
Fourth priority	Children of former students
Fifth priority	Children of school employees
Sixth priority	All other Out of Zone applicants

If your child is already at school at other year levels, you do not need to reapply.

If a ballot is required, it will be held on Wednesday 19th October 2022.

If you have already notified school that your Out of Zone child will be coming to school in 2023 then you do not need to reapply.
