

# **Education Review Office (ERO)**

This week we welcomed a review officer from ERO to commence a review of the school on behalf of the

Education Review Office. This review will involve several visits to the school over the next 3 months, involving visits to classrooms to see teaching and learning, interviews with staff and with students, and a meeting with the school board.

The review will confirm that the school meets all legislative requirements and will provide some feedback to the community about the school in general. The review will also confirm ongoing plans for further improvement, co-constructed with the board and senior leadership team. Parents will be likely to receive the report in early Term 1, 2023.

This morning we welcomed the review officer with a mihi whakatau and a tour of the school led by senior students. Thank you especially to our kapa haka group, and to Connor Ford, Chloe Sundborn and Kainoa Tuimaleilifano who took the reviewer on a tour. They were amazing!



## **Dogs at School**

I remind families that you are welcome to bring your dog to school when dropping off or collecting your children, providing your dog is on a leash. You should also have a doggie poo bag in case you need to clean up any droppings! If you bring your dog onsite after school hours, then please also clean up any mess that your dog leaves behind. Thank you.

If your dog escapes from home and comes on to school property we will catch it, put it on a leash and give it a drink of water. Then we will contact you if we can. If we are unable to do so, then we will call the council dog control.



Every year since 1975 New Zealand has marked Māori Language Week. This is a time for all New Zealanders to celebrate te reo Māori (the Māori language) and to use more Māori phrases in everyday life. In 2022 Te wiki o te reo Māori runs from 19-22 September.

#### At Tirimoana School our teachers:

- Use Māori words and phrases where appropriate and encourage correct pronunciation
- Explore Māori concepts, values and viewpoints, and their relevance
- Integrate te reo Māori and tikanga across the curriculum through planned and incidental learning experiences
- Teach children to create and recall their personal pepeha
- Teach children karakia and waiata
- Engage in their own personal learning of te reo Maori

- Weekly Te Reo Toi mini class (Year 1-3)
- Weekly extension te reo Maori lessons in the senior school

#### Some phrases you might like to use at home.

- Kia ora Hello
- Tēnā koe Hello to one person
- Kia ora/Tēna kōrua Hello to two people
- Kia ora tātou/kia ora koutou Hello everyone
- Tēnā koutou Greetings to you (said to three or more people)
- Nau mai, haere mai Welcome
- Kei te pēhea koe? How are you?
- Kei te pai Good
- Tino pai Really good
- Ka kite anō See you later
- Mā te wā See you next time
- Haere rā Goodbye/farewell (said to someone leaving)
- Hei kona rā Goodbye (said to someone staying)
- As well as being used as a greeting, kia ora is also a general expression of appreciation.
- Tēnā koe (to one person), tēnā kōrua (to two people), or tēnā koutou (to three or more people) also means thank you in Māori.

This only applies to 5-Year-olds who have not pre enrolled.

## Applicants are accepted in the following order:

Out of Zone Application Priorities		
Second priority	Siblings of current students.	
Third priority	Siblings of former students	
Fourth priority	Children of former students	
Fifth priority	Children of school employees	
Sixth priority	All other Out of Zone applicants	

If your child is already at school at other year levels, you do not need to reapply.

If a ballot is required, it will be held on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> October 2022.

If you have already notified school that your Out of Zone child will be coming to school in 2023 then you do not need to reapply.



She writes junior fiction and young adult books. She visits schools often, to do animated, dramatic readings for students.

It will be held during the school holidays, from Tuesday, 11st October 2022 to Thursday, 13th October 2022.
