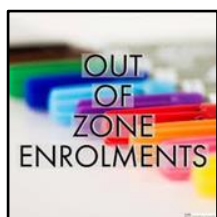

All Out of Zone 5-year-old enrolments for the following priorities need to be submitted to the school by Wednesday 28 September 2022. This is part of the out of zone procedures set down by the Ministry of Education.

**This only applies to 5-Year-olds who have not pre enrolled.**

If your child is already at school at other year levels, you do not need to reapply.

If a ballot is required, it will be held on Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> October 2022.

If you have already notified school that your Out of Zone child will be coming to school in 2023 then you do not need to reapply.
