This week classes have been focused on the different types of play that they can engage in within each play space. Teachers have taken classes to roleplay some games and activities in these spaces.



Today school participated in the National Shake Out Earthquake drill at 9.30am. We practiced what to do if we were ever in an earthquake.




- DROP down on your hands and knees. This protects you from falling but lets you move if you need to.
- COVER your head and neck (or your entire body if possible) under a sturdy table or desk (if it is within a few steps of you). If there is no shelter nearby, cover your head and neck with your arms and hands.
- HOLD on to your shelter (or your position to protect your head and neck) until the shaking stops. If the shaking shifts your shelter around, move with it.

Term 4 Water Skills Programme Y3 - 6

Beginning on Thursday 20th October each Thursday and Friday for five weeks, Year 3 to 6 students will travel to Peninsula School swimming pool to participate in the Water Skills for Life Programme.

The lessons will be run by qualified Swimisation Swim Instructors and cover a variety of water skills. These will cater for all swimming abilities to enable everyone to participate.

Children will travel to and from Peninsula School Pool by bus. There is **NO charge** to families. The first bus will leave school at 9:00am and the last session will return classes to school by 2:30pm.

We ask that parents send children to school with a **named** towel and a plastic-bag or swim bag for wet items. Goggles are permitted but not necessary. School uniform is required to and from the pool.
