National Shake Out! October 27th

Today school participated in the National Shake Out Earthquake drill at 9.30am. We practiced what to do if we were ever in an earthquake.

- DROP down on your hands and knees. This protects you from falling but lets you move if you need to.
- COVER your head and neck (or your entire body if possible) under a sturdy table or desk (if it is within a few steps of you). If there is no shelter nearby, cover your head and neck with your arms and hands.
- HOLD on to your shelter (or your position to protect your head and neck) until the shaking stops. If the shaking shifts your shelter around, move with it.

All children need to wear their school hats or caps outside this term as we head into Summer. Caps and Bucket hats are available to purchase from the school office.




