Teacher Union Strike Day- Thursday 16 March



Dear Parents and Whānau,

The teacher unions (Primary-NZEI and Secondary -PPTA) have organised a teacher strike day for next Thursday as part of their campaign to improve conditions and pay in their collective employment agreements with the Ministry of Education.

Most teachers at Tirimoana School are covered by the NZEI union and will therefore be withdrawing their labour on the strike day. Every school will be affected by the strike.

Our school will be unable to provide teaching and parents will be required to keep their children at home. There will be no before and after school care available on this day.

We regret this disruption to learning and the inconvenience this may cause for many families. We are hopeful that you will understand taking strike action has been a difficult decision for teachers to make. Teachers are hoping that the Ministry of Education will improve their offer and therefore prevent any further industrial action.

We will share more information about this next week, including reasons why teachers are taking this action.

Wear green accessories with your school uniform next Friday




Wanted: Roots of Empathy baby


