This is part of the national strategy to more closely monitor student absences from schools, and to improve overall student attendance.



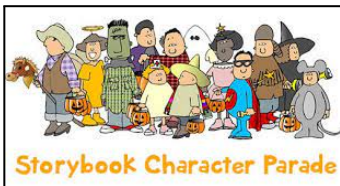
### Parking on Metric Place -
