

## Opening of the new Bike Trail

On Monday afternoon we held a whole school official opening of the new Bike Trail. The project cost over \$130,000 and all of it was funded through various community grants.

We invited special guests to our opening, including [Tamatane Joachim Tuhura](#) who conducted the blessing or takutaku for the trail, and who led our whole school on a hikoi round the trail. Thank you Joachim.

Our other guests included [Jamie Lane from Sport Waitakere/Tu Manawa](#) (which provided a grant to buy all the bikes and helmets); [Toni Dale from Bike On New Zealand](#) who assisted us with all the grant applications and whose organisation helped us plan the trail; [Simon from Auckland Transport](#) who has been involved with our bike safety training and Travelwise programme; [Constable Sarah Jones](#), our School Police Liaison Officer who helps us with road safety and bike training; and [Ben Wood](#) from our school Board who spoke a mihi of acknowledgment for the event.

The bike trail will be used over the next 3 weeks for classes to learn how to ride and look after the fleet of bikes, and to practise bike riding round the trail. Classes will be rostered for this. Children do not need to bring their own bike or helmet, because we will use our own school fleet.



Parents and children are welcome to use the bike trail on the weekends. Bring your own bike and helmet for this.

- And a group prize for the classes who have a 100% sponsorship return


