I remind parents and whanau that the last day of term is **Friday 30 June**, with school closing at 3.00pm.



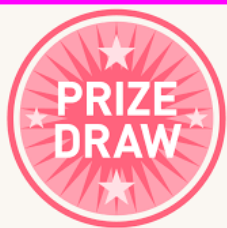
## Safety Drill

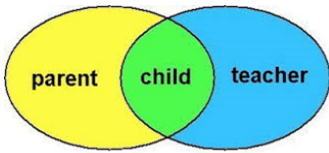


**The Athon prize draws will take place at assembly at 11.30am on Friday 30th June.**
