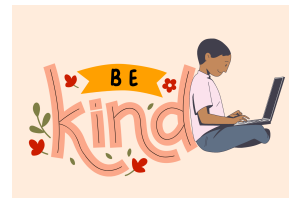

NOTE : Change of days

Monday: Year 5/6 students

Tuesday: Year 4 students

Wednesday: Year 3 students

Thursday: Year 1/2 students

Friday: Scooter, Skates and Skateboard Day



We have adjusted the timetable for year 1 and 2 students to enjoy the bike track lunchtimes on Thursdays.

Year 1 and 2:

- NO bikes from home please- Correct sized school bikes and helmets will be used.
- This is for confident riders only - your child's teacher will help identify the confident riders
- Children are not to use pump track or ramps
- Travelwise monitors to be scattered around the track to assist riders and manage traffic jams

ALL riders MUST wear a Helmet and 'closed toe' shoes.



Bring a change of clothes to school in case your child falls in the mud. The field is closed, there are still muddy areas beside the track.

Friday: Scooters/Skateboards/Skates

On Fridays, all children are welcome to bring their scooters/skateboards and skates from home to use on the bike track. Scooters need to be parked outside classrooms .
No bikes will be on the track on a Friday.



ALL children must wear a helmet (from home) and wear closed toe shoes.
