### **Dogs on School Grounds- a gentle reminder**

Dogs are an important part of life for many Tirimoana families.

Parents who bring dogs on to school grounds do so on the understanding that their dog has no issues around children, has never displayed any aggression towards children, and that the owner believes the dog is fully trustworthy in a school environment. Please remember that some students can find contact with dogs stressful, and even frightening.

We ask that owners bringing a dog or dogs onto the school grounds follow the guidelines below.

- If the dog is considered by the council or any other authority to be a breed that needs muzzling, the dog must be muzzled on school property.
- Dog owners should help educate children about how best to approach their dog.
- Owners must remove any mess left by their dog.

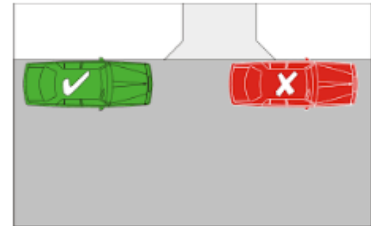

### Term 4 Water Skills for Life Programme

**Coming Up:** Next term Y3 - 6 students will take part in a **Water Skills for Life programme**. This is part of our school-wide Physical Education curriculum.

The **5 x 1 hour sessions** teach children the skills and knowledge they need to assess risk and make responsible decisions around water.

Lessons are held at Peninsula Primary School indoor pool facility and by Swimsation Swim School instructors. Children will travel by bus to and from the pool. There is no cost to parents.

Every Thursday or Friday from 12 Oct (Week 1) to 10 November (Week 5). Please refer to your child's teacher notices for individual class times.

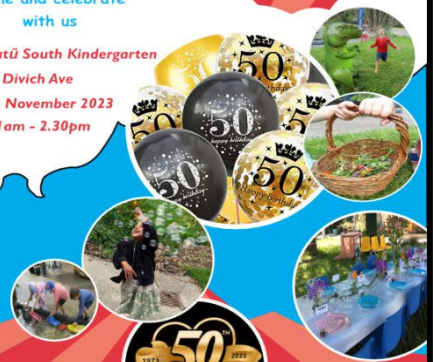
