This week classes have been focused on showing compassion towards each other and thinking about the way we speak to others. Classes have talked about the importance of being open, non-judgemental, listening and replying respectfully towards people. Often there are different situations and different people whom we talk with that require different levels of respect. This week our teachers have begun the big task of allocating children to classes for next year. As in previous years, we have used a number of criteria when making these decisions. We include friendships and ideal learning partners, and sometimes, separating children that negatively impact on others' learning.

We hope that parents will have confidence in our decisions, and that we look carefully at every individual student. We have nearly 600 students to place! We also want our classes to reflect our diverse school, with a spread of cultures and identities, a spread of achievement and a close balance of boys and girls.

Our class lists remain draft till the end of the first week in February, to allow for any extra students that turn up, and if we need to make any adjustments. Children will find out which class they are in at a special assembly on Monday 11th December.

All fees need to be paid a week in advance to ensure placement on the following week's programme. Fees are payable for days booked, irrespective of attendance. We have a **NO REFUND** policy once the Holiday Programme starts.

You will be charged a partial fee of \$20 for same day cancellation.
