This week's PB4L Focus: Digital Citizenship

This week teachers and learners have revisited our Digital Citizenship Programme. This teaches children to think about their behaviour when using digital tools and act in responsible ways. Learners have been discussing the importance of thinking twice before posting anything online, respecting the rights of others as a digital creator and ensuring they are using correct privacy settings when engaging in social media. Please have further conversations with your child about being a responsible Digital Citizen.
