Diversity Day and Chinese New Year!

At the beginning of every school year, teachers focus on building relationships with the children in their new classes. When they do this, teachers and children learn about everyone's personal cultural identities and their families backgrounds. We learn about diversity and about respecting each other's differences. We celebrate this diversity each year with a Diversity Day parade. This happened at school this morning. Teachers and children dressed in clothes that reflect their personal identities, cultural backgrounds and likes. Some come as Kiwi kids, others come in traditional costume, some as sports or movie stars and film characters. Our teachers

and staff dress up too.

Here at Tirimoana School we believe that it is important to celebrate all our heritages, cultures, identities and whakapapa. Family and whanau are important to us all. Today we flew the United Nations flag from our flagpole.



Diversity Day happens at the same time as Chinese New Year. Chinese New Year is celebrated primarily in China and other Asian countries, but increasingly in every country around the world where there are Chinese communities.

Here at Tirimoana School, 15% of our children and their families identify as Chinese, and another 11% come from elsewhere in Asia other than India.

We wish all our families a Happy Chinese New Year! We know that this is a time for families to connect and celebrate together.

Attendance

Our focus continues this year for all students to attend school for at least 90% of the school year.

90% attendance means no more than 5 days absence across a 10 week term.

We are asking you to:

If your child is going to be absent from school you should let the school know as soon as possible.

You need to let us know why your child is away and for how long.

You can contact us via the school app, email or phone call.

What school is doing:


Your child's safety and wellbeing is a priority for the school. If your child doesn't turn up to school we will be concerned for their safety.

If the school doesn't hear from you, we will get in touch with you to make sure your child is okay.

If your child is away for more than 3 days without you contacting us, the classroom teacher will contact you to see how your child is doing.

If there are repeated absences, the classroom teacher will also make contact with you to enquire about your child.

Using the Bike Track at Lunchtimes

Students are able to use the bike track at lunchtimes on scheduled days (with school bikes and children's own bikes from home).

ALL riders MUST wear a Helmet and 'closed toe' shoes.

Monday: Year 6 students

Tuesday: Year 4 and 5 students Wednesday: Year 3 students Thursday: Year 1 and students (students must be competent riders)

Friday: Scooter Day (all year levels)

On Fridays, all children are welcome to bring their scooters from home to scoot on the bike track. **ALL children must wear a helmet (from home) and wear closed toe shoes.** Scooters need to be parked outside classrooms . No bikes will be on track on a Friday.






Walking School Bus - Mornings

We have started a new morning walking school. Mr Kaiser and Gabby, one of our teacher aides, leave the McLeod Road Coffee Shop at 8.30am. They then walk down McLeod Road, turning up Finlow Drive, crossing Divich Ave and enter the school via the Metric Place entrance.

This walking bus will operate every school morning, rain or shine. You can join the walking school bus at any point along the route below.







For the safety of your child, please make sure your child joins the walking bus before you leave them (please do not leave children unattended).

Safety when walking to and from school

If your child walks to or from school unsupervised, please talk to them about road safety and how to cross the road.

We have had two reports from concerned adults this week of Tirimoana students running across busy roads without checking if it is safe. The surrounding area has a lot of cars parked on the sides of roads and this can make it difficult for drivers to see children.



Every learner is expected to wear a Tirimoana bucket hat or school cap. These can be purchased for \$12 from the office.



Dear parents and caregivers,

The Auckland Regional Dental Service (ARDS) is a Te Whatu Ora-operated service, which provides FREE dental care to children across greater Auckland. In order to prevent any eligible children missing out on receiving free dental care, ARDS is cross-checking their own records with school rolls. Mobile Library Bus visiting our school

In 2024 the Auckland Libraries Mobile Library Bus will begin visiting our school and all of our tamariki will get the opportunity to jump aboard and choose 1 or 2 books. This is a wonderful opportunity for them.

During 2024 if you already have your child signed up as a Library

Member they will use this membership to issue a <u>maximum</u> number of 2 items. There are no overdue fines for these cards.

Those children who are not already library members can be issued with a 'Starter Card' which lets them borrow a maximum of 2 items, which Auckland Libraries will take responsibility for (you will receive reminders though via e-mail or post if items are overdue, however there will be no late fees or replacement costs to you).

Please help us retain this wonderful service and encourage respect for books by helping your child return their books to school or your local public Library (Ranui).

Children do-not need to bring their card to school, and you are welcome to visit your local Library to use their services too.

Please note that in order for children to have this opportunity we give your child's details to Auckland Libraries. This info will be used for creating the membership card <u>only</u>. Please notify the office if you DON'T wish this to happen or have privacy concerns. Likewise if your child has an existing membership & you <u>do</u> <u>-not</u> wish them to use this card please let us know.
