No cell phones at school during the school day

The government has ruled that students may not use cell phones during the school day. We are in the process of updating our procedures for this, and we welcome your views.

We propose that if your child needs a cell phone as part of the family plan for getting home after school, then children must hand in the cell phone into the school office before they start school. They may collect it from the office at hometime. We prefer that children do not bring a cell phone to school. Teachers will not be responsible for cell phones, and children are not allowed to keep them in their school bag.

We also propose that children may not take cell phones on school trips. Our teachers will have cell phones when they take children on trips, so in any emergency, parents may contact the teacher to get a message to children, or to check on their wellbeing.

The no cell phones in school policy applies to all primary, intermediate and secondary schools in New Zealand.



Please make suitable arrangements for your child to stay home on this day.


Fruit


