


Adults Using Student Toilets

It has come to our attention that an adult may have used a student toilet before school. Please be aware that all our student toilets are for the exclusive use of children and that adults must not enter them. This is to ensure child safety and privacy. If you are on the school premises and need to use a toilet or bathroom, please just ask any staff member to direct you to one of our adult toilets.

Monitoring Student Behaviour

I assure parents that staff monitor student behaviour in the playground during break times, and before or after school. If you witness anything of concern, please inform the school office or a staff member. We have nearly 650 children at Tirimoana School, and generally we are aware of only a very small number of children who occasionally are disrespectful, use bad language or are physically aggressive to someone else. This number is less than 10 students. We use strategies to change behaviour, and we use consequences for poor behaviour. We also inform their parents when we have a concern about behaviour.



Please do not do U turns by the school crossing on Kokiri Street

We suggest you drive down Kokiri Street to collect your child and continue your journey away from school via Nui Mana place. This may help ease congestion.

Keeping our students safe at drop off and pick up is important to all of us. Please be responsible when parking and driving around the School.




Bike Raffle: Barfoot and Thompson have donated 2 bikes to local schools. All raffle money raised by Tirimoana School stays at our school.
