Board Elections

In September, every school in New Zealand will participate in board elections for new boards to govern schools for the next 3 years. Every parent has the right to vote in the elections, and to nominate another parent or themselves for elections. This Wednesday the board will meet at 7:30 in the staffroom. Board meetings are open and if you would like to come along to see what it is all about then you are more than welcome to.

Moving Schools?

Families often move house, and this change can bring about a shift in school for children. If your child is moving on from Tirimoana please inform the office so that we can plan and manage your child's transition to their new school.

Important Update: School Medication Procedures

We've updated our school's medication administration procedures to align with our Medicines School Policy, ensuring the safety of all students and compliance with regulations.

Here are the key changes:

- All medication brought to school must be in its original packaging, clearly showing your child's name, dose, and instructions.
- Medication must be delivered by a parent or caregiver, not by students.
- A new Medicine Authority Form must be completed and returned for all medications. If we currently hold any prescribed medication for your child at school (e.g., an asthma inhaler or EpiPen), a separate notice will be sent home for you to complete and return this new form as soon as possible.
