Kia ora e te whānau

We hope you all had a safe and wonderful holiday with your family. Term 3 has started well with students and teachers refreshed and ready for a busy term of learning. Classes are continuing their focus on science and are building up to a Science Expo evening that will be held on the last Thursday of this Term. Whānau and the community will be invited to come and see and share with the students all the learning that they have been doing.

We have welcomed a lot of new learners who have recently turned 5 years old to Tirimoana. These students have started their schooling in Room 1 with Miss Telfer. We are expecting this class to continue to grow through the term as more children turn 5 and come to join us.

The weather has been particularly cold and wet lately, and the school grounds are very wet. Students are encouraged to keep dry and off the grassed areas, but we have not closed our fields. If students do get wet or muddy however the school does not have spare clothes to change children into.

Project Jonah



Next week classes will be given the opportunity to partake in an education session with Project Jonah. Project Jonah is a volunteer organisation with a focus of protecting and helping marine mammals through rescue, action and protection programmes. Learners will participate in an educational session where they will learn about the humpback whale. They will also be able to go inside a life size inflatable replica of a whale.

We ask for learners to bring a **gold coin donation** to school next Monday 21st July to gift to Project Jonah to use towards their rescue programmes.
