End of Year Reports

Tomorrow students will be given their end of year report. This report is for parents and whānau. We hope that you will spend time discussing it with your child, acknowledging their effort and progress. It is very important that children feel their parents celebrate their learning.

The reports include data that has been collected recently about your child's progress. This gives only one piece of information about your child's learning. Teachers also use a range of other sources including observation of your child, evidence from their exercise books and class tests, and conversations with your child about their learning to develop an overall judgement of your child's learning progress.

Each year we welcome grandparents to school to join with their grandchildren in the class to take part in fun handson activities and then join other grandparents and staff in the hall for a morning tea at 10:30am to 11:10am. We hope to see them there.

Cultural Performance Evening

Measles

Given the recent measles cases confirmed in the wider New Zealand community, we want to urge all our school families to remain vigilant and ensure their children's vaccinations are up-to-date.

Measles is highly contagious. It is much more serious than a regular cold or flu, often requiring hospitalisation, and can have severe complications. Immunity is the best protection for our children and our community.

Two doses of the MMR (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) vaccine provides the best protection. The MMR vaccine is free. You can book via your GP or at bookmyvaccine.health.nz

If your child shows any symptoms of measles (fever, runny nose, cough, sore red eyes, followed by a rash), please keep them home and call your GP for advice.

Te Tiriti

Our Board will be discussing the place of Te Tiriti within our kura at its next meeting Wednesday 19 November at 7pm. It is likely that our school will develop a clear statement about how the school will uphold the principles of Te Tiriti inline with many other local schools. The government has signalled that Boards will not have to include Te Tiriti but across the education sector, principals and Boards are uniting against this.
