Reaffirming Our Commitment to Te Tiriti o Waitangi

"Kia whakatōmuri te haere whakamua - we walk backwards into the future with our eyes fixed on the past."

This whakataukī reminds us that our future direction must be grounded in our whakapapa, our history, and the commitments that shaped Aotearoa.

We want to acknowledge the government's recent decision to remove the requirement for school boards to give effect to Te Tiriti o Waitangi. While we understand the direction being signalled at a national level, it is important that we recognise who we are as a school and as a community.

For decades, evidence and lived experience in Aotearoa have shown that Māori learners thrive when their language, identity, and culture are upheld in their learning environment. And this does not relate only to Māori ākonga. This is the home of all our children. Being part of Te Ao Māori strengthens belonging, unity, and connection for every learner who walks through our gates. It enriches our shared identity and fosters a sense of whānau across our kura.

The need to uphold Te Tiriti has not disappeared because of a policy change. The values that anchor our school manaakitanga, whanaungatanga, partnership, equity, and belonging remain unchanged. Te Tiriti o Waitangi is the foundational relationship of our nation. It speaks to partnership, shared responsibility, and honouring mana whenua. These are not political ideas. They are the foundations of who we are in Aotearoa.

As a Board, we strongly affirm and uphold the importance of Te Tiriti o Waitangi in the culture, direction, strategic planning, values and practices of Tirimoana School. We are committed to ensuring that the principles of Te Tiriti continue to guide our decisions, our relationships, and the everyday experiences of our ākonga, regardless of legislative requirements.

Our children deserve an environment that reflects who they are, connects them, and supports them to thrive. Our responsibility to our tamariki, our whānau, and to this whenua remains the same.

Library Books

Reports

Staff Carpark and School Driveways

Please do not use the staff carparks (off Kokiri and Metric Place) as well as ensuring that you are not parked over any of the driveways or on the yellow lines around the school. These areas are "no parking" spaces to ensure the safety of all students and road users. In an event of an emergency we must have access to the school to allow emergency vehicles to enter the property.

Measles

To help ensure the continuity of your child's learning and protection against infectious disease, we are proactively sharing information regarding the MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella) vaccine. Measles is highly contagious, and children without evidence of immunity may be required to stand down from school if there is an outbreak. To help us act quickly and responsibly, we ask you to take the following steps:

- We strongly recommend checking that your child has received the necessary two doses of the MMR vaccine for full protection. You can verify this status via your My Health Record or by contacting your medical provider.
- If your child was vaccinated overseas, those records are not automatically entered into the Aotearoa Immunisation Register (AIR). Please provide these records to your GP as soon as possible. Your GP must manually enter this information into the national register. Ensuring your child's records are up-to-date on the AIR is critical to avoid potential delays in a school stand-down scenario.

The MMR vaccine is free for those who need it. Pharmacies are currently the easiest and fastest way to get immunised.


